



The project «EUDIGIT» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project involved 657 citizens, notably 77 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (Romania), 93 participants from the city of Genoa (Italy), 164 participants from the city of Hamburg (Germany), 97 participants from the city of Marseille (France), 130 participants from the city of Rotterdam (Netherlands), 96 participants from the city of Varna (Bulgaria). (*)

Locations/ Dates: The events took place in Cluj-Napoca (Romania), Genoa (Italy), Hamburg (Germany), Marseille (2 times; France), Rotterdam (Netherlands) and Varna (Bulgaria) from 01/04/2020 to 30/03/2023.

Short description:

The days of 07/10/2020 and 08/10/2020 were dedicated to the partners' kick-off meeting and the opening conference (Marseille).

The days of 25/02/2021 and 26/02/2021 were dedicated to "The youth, the digital divide and citizenship" (Varna).

The days of 17/06/2021 and 18/06/2021 were dedicated to "The elderly, the digital divide and citizenship" (Hamburg).

The days of 16/12/2021 and 17/12/2021 were dedicated to "The local communication, the digital tools and citizenship" (Genoa).

The days of 11/03/2022 and 12/03/2022 were dedicated to "The disabled persons, the digital divide and Citizenship" (Rotterdam).

The days of 06/12/2022 and 07/12/2022 were dedicated to "The gap between rural and urban areas, the digital divide and citizenship" (Cluj-Napoca).

The days of 22/03/2023 and 23/03/2023 were dedicated to the final conference of the project (Marseille).

Event 1

Participation: The event involved 37 citizens, including 2 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (Romania), 3 Participants from the city of Genoa (Italy), 4 participants from the city of Hamburg (Germany), 12 participants from Bulgaria, 3 participants from the city of Rotterdam (Netherlands), 13 participants from Marseille (France) .

Location / Dates: The event took place in Marseille (France), from 07/10/2020 to 08/10/2020.

Short description: The aim was to present the project and discuss the objectives with the partners.

Event 2

Participation: The event involved 96 citizens, including 30 participants from Bulgaria, 23 participants from France, 2 from the UK, 4 participants from Greece, 6 from Germany, 2 participants from Australia, 15 participants from Italy, 4 participants from Romania, 4 participants from Portugal, 6 participants from The Netherlands, 1 participant from South Africa, Pakistan, Indonesia, Austria, Spain, Denmark, 2 participants from Lithuania.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Varna (Bulgaria), from 25/02/2021 to 26/02/2021.

Short description: The aim of the event was to discuss about the youth, the digital divide and citizenship, and exchange best practices between cities.

Event 3

Participation: The event involved 164 citizens, including 80 participants from Germany, 19 participants from Bulgaria, 3 participants from Italy, 3 participants from the Netherlands, 2 participants from Norway, 4 participants from Romania, 4 participants from France, 1 participant from Slovakia, Slovenia, Hungary, the USA, Portugal, Poland, 4 participants from the UK and other countries.

Location / Dates: The event took place in Hamburg (Germany), from 17/06/2021 to 18/06/2021.

Short description: The aim of the event was to exchange experiences and best practices on The elderly, the digital divide and citizenship.

Event 4

Event 5

Event 6
